FLOYD – Marguerite Irene Tise, 89, passed away Thursday, August 8, 2002. Miss Tise, a well-known local historian, was retired from government service.

She is survived by her sister, Jessie Heafner of Floyd, and will be sadly missed by her friends in the community.

She was born March 9, 1913 in Roanoke County. A graduate of Floyd High School, she furthered her education and received degrees from Marion College in Marion and Roanoke College in Salem.

She taught at an elementary school in Floyd County before accepting a position in Washington, DC. There she worked in the State Department in foreign service.

In her retirement years she lived in Floyd, where she enjoyed studying local history and compiling genealogies. She was an active member of the Floyd County Historical Society. She was also a member of the Floyd Courthouse Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution. She attended Zion Lutheran Church, where she was a member of the Zion Ladies Aid Society.

A funeral service was conducted on Saturday, August 10, at 2:00 p.m. at the Zion Lutheran Church in Floyd with Rev. Paul Pingel officiating. Interment was at the Jacksonville Cemetery.
